

Subject: A message from the CEO - COVID-19 update - 14 July 2020

Good morning,

A new digital screening tool is now available to make it easier to determine if it is safe for someone to enter a health facility.

From today, in line with visitor restrictions tightening, visitors must fill the screening tool in before entering a health facility in the ACT. We may also require staff to use this in coming days. The screening tool involves answering a series of simple questions. A green tick or red cross will indicate whether or not it is safe to enter. Those using the tool can show the screening staff the 'green tick' before they enter the facility.

If visitors do not have a mobile phone or do not wish to download the form, they will need to answer the same questions at the screening desk before being allowed to enter a facility.

To access the online screening tool, simply:

- scan the QR code on the health screening posters as you enter the hospital

OR

- Fill in your details online at screening.covid19.act.gov.au

OR

- Fill in a form at the screening desk.

The screening tool will be available on the ACT Health App soon.
